We've made it really clear what we think would make the offer fair. The University needs to re-negotiate the terms and conditions statement, improve the pay offer, and make the allowances for weekend and night work fair for all. We don't want anyone to be left behind.

An accessible picket line will be available for anyone not able to attend in person and your messages will be shared on the day so you can still take part.

If you are support staff but haven't joined yet you can join right up until the day and still receive strike pay - you can claim up to the amount you've lost from your wages.

If you aren't a member of support staff you can still support us by sharing our links, speaking up for us in your part of the University and coming to our rallies at lunchtime. Whether you've signed the new terms or conditions or not, you are still welcome, and we hope you can still help us win this dispute. We are still in this together and the outcome will affect us all.
